GUEST SPEAKERS

In 2014 Pastor Chandler accepted a call to the Capitol City Seventh-day Adventist Church, in Sacramento California where he now serves as senior pastor.



ATLANTIC UNION VIRTUAL CAMPOREE SAFETY TIPS FOR CAMPERS & FAMILIES

- Parents/guardians are asked to maintain communication with campers during the camporee, and 'wear the hat' of the onsite counselor/club staff especially for younger children.
- All camporee attendees need to bear in mind that they are in the public once logged on to the zoom platforms.
- While online, practice cybersecurity measures for every camper's safety. All parents/ guardians are asked to be aware of 'where' their children are when on virtual platforms.
- Anyone receiving threatening or inappropriate chat messages should immediately report it to a trusted adult parent/guardian, director, zoom host, staff, etc.
- All campers are asked to avoid sharing personal details or share information with care; do not disclose personal data.
- All families are asked to be vigilant about calibrating their computer's/device's security settings especially for younger children (limit access to other unwanted sites/apps, etc).
- Pathfinders, and families are also reminded to place devices in neutral, appropriate locations away from bedrooms, etc. so that embarrassing situations are avoided (your family is in the public when online).
- Utilize the virtual background that has been provided so that the inside of your home will not be in the public's eyes.
- Be intentional about ensuring cybersecurity for all campers.
